



Hanscome

An uninhabited storage space with a large attic above became an opportunity for a complex sustainable solution, with goal of achieving significantly lowered interior temperatures and a passive air circulation system without much reconstruction. The design strategy included mitigating heat build up, opening and closing at specific time intervals existing doors and windows, activating and installing a new fan- based air circulation system, providing additional high-level insulation and creating a cool to warm upward air movement within the space, without alteration of existing exterior. The south facing large openings were found to be insulated R-7. New batt insulation R-39 and R-21 at the south wall were installed. New fans, including a Broan 700 CFM exhaust system on an automated timer was added, and the existing south facing attic fan was replaced and placed on timer. A new screen opening at the north face was specified with operable upper and lower window closure. The existing concrete floor assisted in providing a baseline temperature of 55 degrees. South facing exhaust louver was replaced with a fire resistant metal.
